

Rediscover Jesus by Matthew Kelly



Jesus: The Way, The Truth, and The Life


by Dr. Marcellino D'Ambrosio



The Case for Jesus by Dr. Brant Pitre



A Biblical Walk Through The Mass by Dr. Edward Sri





Book Recommendations on the Eucharist/Mass




Real Presence by Dr. Tim O'Malley


Becoming Eucharistic People by Dr. Tim O'Malley


The Lamb's Supper by Dr. Scott Hahn


The Fourth Cup by Dr. Scott Hahn




Book Recommendations on Eucharistic Saints



Carlo Acutis: A Millenial in Paradise




My Son Carlo: Carlo Acutis Through the Eyes of His Mother by Antonia Salzano Acutis




How to Get More Out of Holy Communion

by St. Peter Julian Eymard


